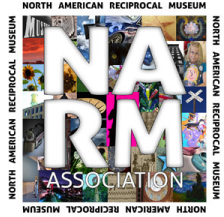


We are pleased to announce a new benefit for our members! The \$125 Contributor level and above members are now enrolled in the **North American Reciprocal Museum Association (NARM)**.
