- 7. Judging takes place at 2:00 on Saturday, and winners will be announced following judging (approx 2:45)
- 8. Judging criteria will include overall appearance, crust, flavor, and texture
- 9. All pies are donations to the Litchfield Historical Society and will be served to festival goers after judging.
