2. All participants must register for the contest by Wednesday, October 2nd
3. Participants supply their own tools and ingredients.
4. All pies must be made with apples, and must be homemade.
5. Pie plates must be labeled on the bottom with your name and phone number.
6. Pies must be dropped off at the Apple Pie contest table on Saturday between 11:30 and 1:30 pm
7. Judging takes place at 2:00 on Saturday, and winners will be announced following judging (approx 2:45)
8. Judging criteria will include overall appearance, crust, flavor, and texture
9. All pies are donations to the Litchfield Historical Society and will be served to festival goers after judging.
