The Code Book

Use the excerpts from the Culper Spy Ring's code book to decode the attached letter. Then write you own coded letter!

- When writing IN CODE, find the letter, number, or word you wish to write in the left column and replace it with the coded letter or number from the right column. When you are DECODING you will find the letter or number in code in the right column and replace it with the correct letter in the left column.
- When you use this form of code always draw a line under the word. For instance the word send would be written as <u>uiph</u>. Numbers represented by letters which must have a double line under them as <u>fik</u> is 245.
- When you are using numbers to represent words, place a period after the number. If the same word needs to be changed into a different number or tense, make a flourish (~) over the number. For example **356** is letter, **356** is letters and **167** is enclose, **167** is enclosed.
